JEFFERSON BARRACKS AIR NATIONAL GUARD STATION—The Missouri Army National Guard (MOARNG) on behalf of the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) has renovated historic Building 00027 at Jefferson Barracks Air National Guard Station, located along Interstate 255/U.S. Highway 50, approximately 12 miles south of downtown St. Louis, Missouri.

Building 00027, built in 1898 as a Double Cavalry Barracks is a contributing element to the Jefferson Historic District. The renovation works supports the construction of Joint Reserve Intelligence Center (JRIC).

The MOARNG is in consultation with the Missouri State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP), and also invites the public to comment on the renovation undertaking in accordance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.
