

No 2. PUBLIC NOTICE OF BUILDING 00027 ANNEX BASEMENT WINDOW ENCLOSURES FROM THE MISSOURI ARMY NATIONAL GUARD JEFFERSON BARRACKS

JEFFERSON BARRACKS AIR NATIONAL GUARD STATION—The Missouri Army National Guard (MOARNG) proposes to in-fill the basement windows of Building 00027 Annex, at Jefferson Barracks Air National Guard Station, located along Interstate 255/U.S. Highway 50, approximately 12 miles south of downtown St. Louis, Missouri.

Building 00027 Annex, built in 1940 as a Mess and Kitchen for the Double Cavalry Barracks (Building 27) is a contributing element to the Jefferson Historic District. The basement windows in-fill work supports the construction of a Joint Reserve Intelligence Center (JRIC).

The MOARNG is in consultation with the Missouri State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP), and also invites the public comment on the renovation undertaking in accordance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.
