Early intervention is key to preventing a crisis. We often hear that Service Members do not seek mental health treatment because they don't have health insurance, or they don't have the money to cover out-of-pocket costs. This list includes information about mental health agencies throughout the state of Missouri that offer free or sliding scale services. Sliding scale means that costs will be determined based on income, rather than flat rates. If you have health insurance, you can still use the services, but they will run costs through your insurance first. Some organizations have grant funding to cover the costs in full for Service Members. We've outlined some of those agencies below, but always ask about funding for Service Members no matter what agency you go with! You never know what they have to offer unless you ask.

Military One Source

Military One Source offers **12 FREE SESSIONS** of in-person, virtual, or phone therapy per situation, meaning you can access them several times throughout your time in service. They provide non-medical counseling for Service Members and their immediate family members. They are a wonderful resource for folks who are struggling with life changes, work stressors, family dysfunction, relationship strain, etc. They are *not* able to assist with serious symptoms and diagnoses which require longer term or more intensive treatment. You can call, use their website, or download their app to arrange for counseling sessions. Of note: Because the sessions are non-medical in nature, Military OneSource providers do not complete or provide the appropriate documentation needed for those on a BH profile, so they *cannot assist Soldiers who are seeking care related to a temporary BH profile*.

Vet Centers

Vet Center counseling services are *FREE*. The Vet Centers fall under the umbrella of the Department of Veterans Affairs, but they are separate from the VA hospitals, and their services are completely confidential. Thus, no outside provider or agency, including the National Guard, has access to any of their records. Vet Centers offer supportive services for Veterans, Service Members, and their families at no cost. Their services include counseling for needs such as depression, post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), and psychological effects of military sexual trauma (MST). To be eligible for long-term services, a Service Member needs to have served in a combat theater or experienced MST. However, they don't turn any Service Member away, and if you need more than short term help, they can also connect you with services through the VA or in your community. All four locations (see below) offer face-to-face and virtual services, offering coverage for Service Members and Veterans anywhere in the state of Missouri. Of note: Vet Centers have a non-medical care model, and therefore do not provide the appropriate documentation needed for those on a BH profile, so they should *not be the sole BH provider for Soldiers seeking care related to a temporary BH profile*. If a Soldier is already involved in Vet Center services, they can continue, but will need to establish care with another BH provider who can supply required documentation.

Department of Veterans Affairs - VA Health Care

The Veterans Health Administration (VHA) provides medical, mental health, peer support and other specialty services to *eligible* Service Members. VHA is separate from the Veterans Benefits Administration (VBA) which houses all other Veteran benefits such as home loans, service-connected compensation, vocational services, burial, etc. Eligibility for VA healthcare can be complex, but there are some basic eligibility criteria:

- National Guard Service Members who have completed a federal tour (Title 10) are eligible. This does not include active time for training purposes only
- Service members who completed 24 consecutive months of active duty (AGR, ADOS, etc.)

There are a few different ways to enroll in VA healthcare:

Once you've enrolled, you can then be established with a primary care provider, mental health services, specialty care providers, and more. If you have health insurance, it will be put on file and run as primary insurance, but copays can be minimized depending on your financial status. Compass offers several different levels/types of care, including individual therapy, group therapy, psychiatry (medications), crisis response, and more. To get established with services, simply walk-in to any location, Mon-Fri, 8AM-4PM, to complete an initial assessment. From there, you will be scheduled with the most appropriate provider for ongoing treatment. Compass also has grant funding to cover costs for Service Members who qualify, depending on your location and financial situation. So, services could be *FREE*. If you are unable to pay copays or other costs, let your provider know and they can help fill out the necessary paperwork to apply for any available grant funding. Their website has tons of helpful information, including the business hours for each location. Some of them are open early/late, to accommodate patients' work schedules.

To get established with services, you can call the one of the numbers above and request an appointment. Some locations offer walk-in availability, but not all of them. You can access their website to find the details and phone numbers for specific locations. BBH also has grant funding to cover costs for Service Members if they are unable to afford it. So, services could be *FREE*. If you cannot pay for your care, then talk with your providers and they can help fill out the appropriate paperwork.

Give An Hour is a non-profit organization that maintains a registry of trained behavioral health providers who have agreed to provide free counseling services to Service Members and Veterans. There is not always guaranteed provider availability, as each provider volunteers their time and has a limited number of pro bono spots they offer.
