Maintains and operates jet fuel, ground fuel and liquid oxygen facilities and equipment. Receives, stores, and issues petroleum, liquid products to aircraft and base vehicles. Also performs quality control analysis on petroleum and liquid oxygen products utilizing a state-of-the-art fuels laboratory and equipment. Performs preventative and operator maintenance on fuel dispensing vehicles and pumping equipment, fuel dispensing systems, and conducts operator inspection and maintenance on fuels and oxygen facilities. Prepares receipt, inventory, and issue documents to support fuel and liquid oxygen product accountability using computers high tech automatic tank gauging systems. Operates specialized mobile fuels vehicles and support equipment in a mobility environment.
